Information for Breastfeeding Families Check List for Essentials of Positioning And Latch

Positioning

- Tuck baby close to mom with back straight.
- Use pillow to support baby's
- bottom.
- Hold head behind ears, baby's
- head slightly extended.
- Line up baby's nose with

nipple.



Check the latch

- Look for flanged lips, open mouth to 140°.
- Ensure no pain, no wedged
- or creased nipple.
- Check that chin is touching
- breast, asymmetrical latch.

Offer the breast

- Line your fingers up with baby's lips, ensuring a large portion of your breast is offered to the baby.
- Use sandwich hold
- (squeeze areola gently).
- Aim your nipple between
- baby's nose and top lip.
- Place baby's lower lip on
- the breast, about 1 inch
- below the nipple.
- Bring baby to breast, not
- breast to baby, quickly,
- chin first.

Assess milk transfer

- Watch for wide jaw movements.
- Look for consistent sucking.
- Listen for swallowing (after milk comes
 - in).
